The older I am, the more people I meet, the ever more grateful I am to God that I am a Catholic Christian and have faith, love and hope.

I avoided the wrong gates – sex, drugs and rocknroll of the 60s,

I have come across too many who made a fortune - at the cost of destroying their family.

Sensing the Kingdom of God - God's presence in all – enables you to have life to the full.

I like - and often use - the little story of the four workers on a building site.

Along comes a social science undergraduate and asks each one in turn, what they are doing.

- 2. "Clearly, I am building a house."

Which of the four is correct? The forth is enjoying a richer life than the other three. His view includes yet transcends their perception of reality.

Read the Gospels – slowly. And look for his strength – as he pulled up Peter out of the water – his intelligence, emotional sensitivity, prayer life – and sense of humour; so often, by so many, for such a long time overlooked. Imagine the smile on his face when he called Simon – that Jelly of a Man - Peter. When he spoke about straining a gnat and swallowing a camel, parents giving their children a snake when they asked for a fish, a scorpion when they asked for an egg. "What fool would place a lamp under a bushel basket or under a bed and not on the lampstand?"

I believe - I am pretty certain - that when Jesus said, "and when you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by others." (Mt 6, 16) he would have pulled a long-look face.


