A Journey to Eternity - The Early Years 1939-1959

Sunday 28th May 2023 - Pentecost

In the Ascension Day gospel (Mt 28, 20), Jesus Christ reminds his disciples – that is you and me – that he is with us always; "yes, to the end of time."

You see, Jesus had to go so the Holy Spirit could come by. However, though God is Three, God is also One and thus Jesus stays with us in the Spirit and – indeed – together with The Father. At the start of every mass we pronounce "In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." – to remind ourselves that life has five dimensions: three spatial – height, width and breadth – the fourth time and the fifth the divine dimension.

We are not forced to be aware of the fifth but "To live life to the full" (Jn 10,10), we need to enjoy that fifth one.

As Pentecost is the birthday of the Church, how about making a new year's resolution to "live life more fully on that divine dimension?" – by working on developing your sense of God's presence. It will enrich your life.

Little things can add up to a lot.

- Tuesday 16, 11.30 Concelebrated at the funeral mass of Fr Henry Young with whom I had been on the CVMS staff 1973-85.
- Having been chaplain to The Papal Knights since 1985, at 4.00pm I celebrated mass for their Committee in the Westminster Cathedral Crypt.
- As their Parish Priest was unwell, on Wednesday 17th and Thursday 18th, feast of the Ascension, I celebrated masses at the Heston Parish of Our Lady Queen of the Apostles. The Thursday mass was attended by the pupils and Staff of The Rosary Primary school, neighbours of the Parish Church in one of whose houses I have my flat.
- Tuesday 23rd at St Mary's University, Twickenham, I concelebrated mass with Bernt Ivar Eidsvig, Bishop of Oslo, Norway, who was at SMU researching possibilities of sending his seminarians to London rather than Rome.
- Thursday 25 welcomed Bob Sims of The National Churches Trust to Vaughan House. As the NCT fundraiser, he is seeking to increase donations as an anonymous benefactor said that, if they raised £500,000 this year, he would match the half a million pounds raised.
