It has kept me energised and motivated as I believe that though I have for ever that I live as I might die tonight.

Time is short - as it was shorter than expected by all those who gave their lives for their country.

Let us remember them and use our time creatively in helping God make this world a better – or at least a less awful – place. Time is like a staircase on which we can go up or down.
